

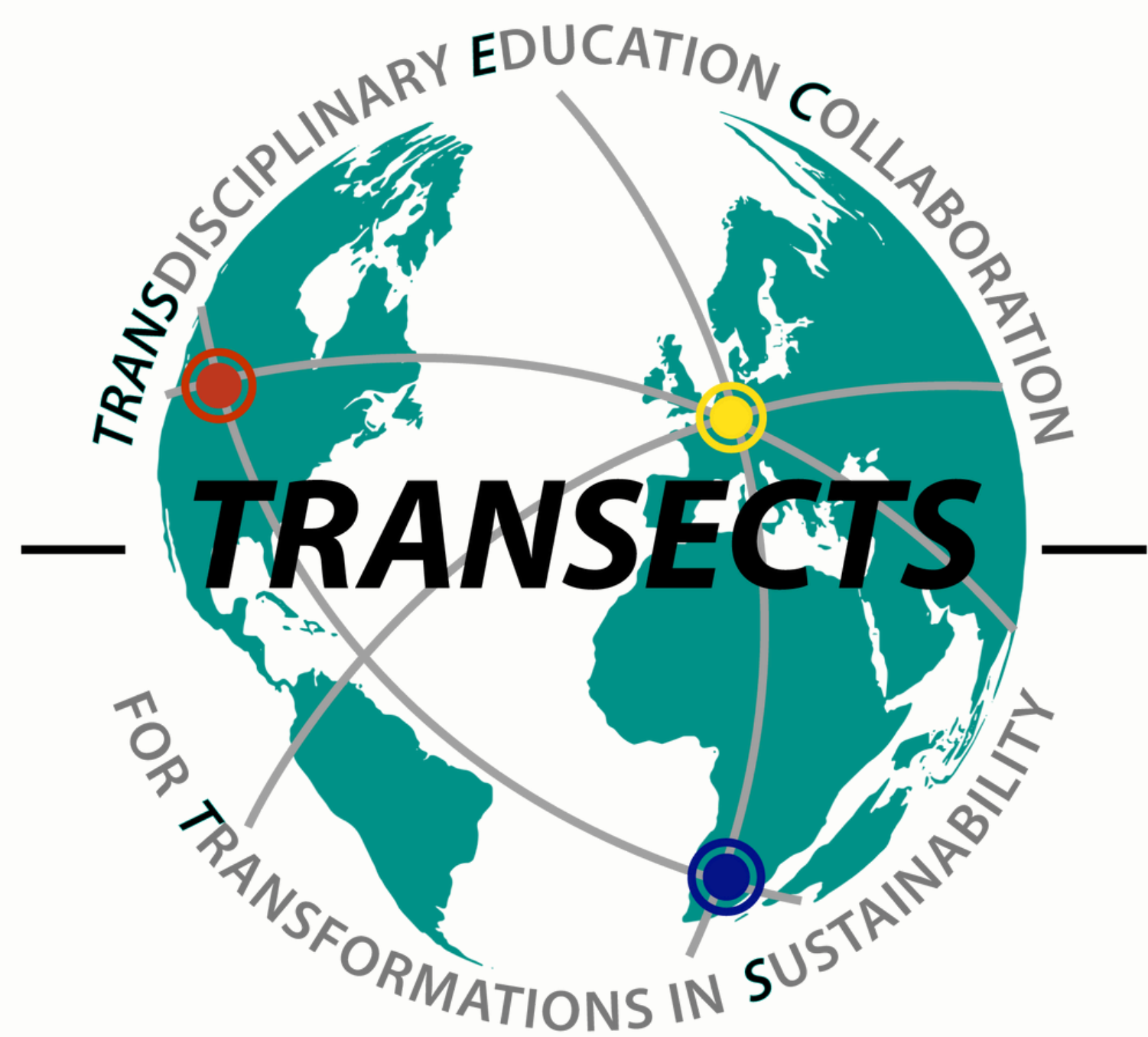

The TILL offers trainees from Canada, South Africa, and Germany the opportunity to deepen their professional, relational, and intercultural skills and provides an introduction to effectively apply transdisciplinary collaboration to tackle interconnected sustainability challenges. Under the mentorship of applied researchers and community partners, the international trainee teams will develop a systematic understanding of Coastal and Marine Protected Areas in the Garden Route Biosphere Reserve (GRBR). Through a creative strategy design, trainee teams will address local issues that are aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals and the GRBR's research and development needs. The TILL is designed to create a community of practice in which participants share a common passion and desire to learn from one another. We seek a practice built on respect and reciprocity that is based on curiosity, collaboration, connection, and accountability.



PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

You are enrolled as a student (Senior Undergraduate, Master's, or PhD) or Postdoctoral Fellow at one of the TRANSECTS partner universities (see above).

COSTS

Expenses for travel and living in the region will be covered by TRANSECTS. Additionally, trainees will receive a monthly stipend for local transportation, certain meals, and other additional costs to participate. No tuition fees apply.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Strong English skills, both written and spoken. A professional recommends you for funding through the program. Your application package and referee form are submitted within the given timeframe.
